

## My Skills Website

My Skills offers a one-stop website where individuals, students, job seekers and employers can find the training and training organisations that best suits their needs.

My Skills is an integral part of the Commonwealth, State and Territory Governments' ongoing skills reform agenda.

My Skills was launched in October 2012, and was upgraded in February 2013 to allow registered training organisations (RTOs) the opportunity to offer additional information about the courses they offer and locations where these courses are delivered. This provision of additional information is voluntary and controlled by the RTO.

### Features of the website

My Skills currently provides information on:

- Nationally recognised training courses
- RTOs, their campuses and services
- The different types of training delivery offered by these RTOs
- The availability of training at a particular location
- VET FEE HELP loan availability



### Key benefits to RTOs

- A no cost opportunity for an RTO to advertise nationally the courses they offer on a site actively promoted by the Commonwealth, State and Territory Governments at Skills Expos, schools and via other advertising campaigns
- Jobseekers' searches for labour force opportunities potentially leading to information about their courses
