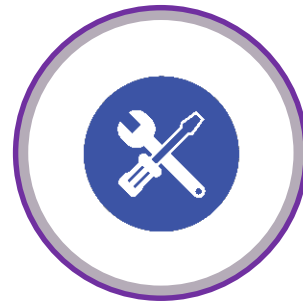

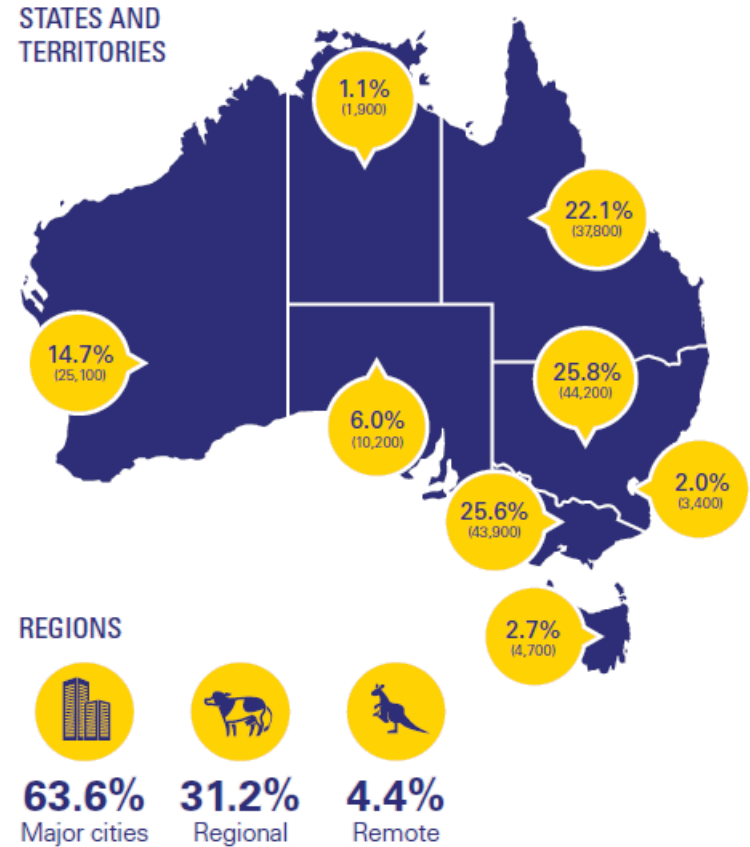
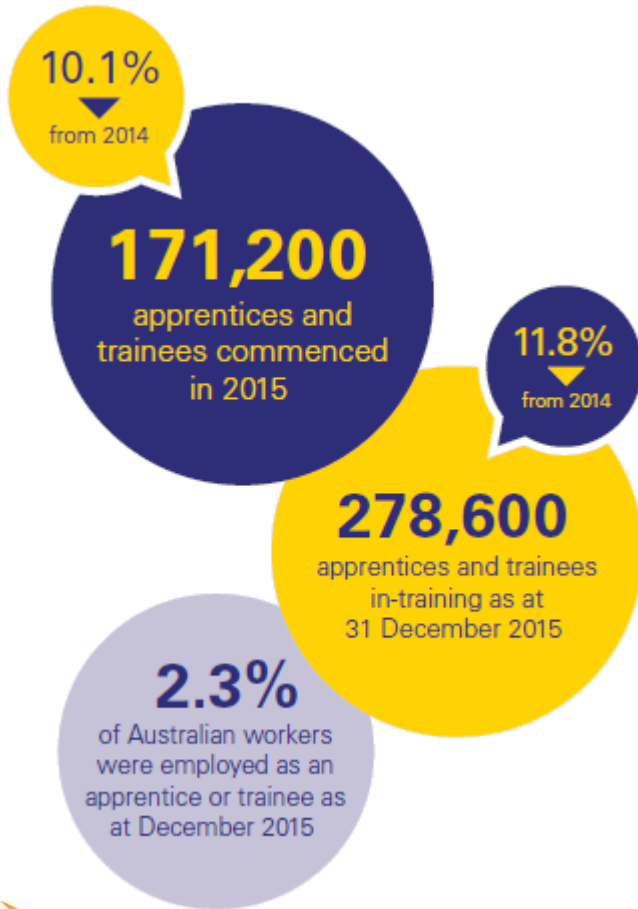

Trade and non-trade participation

Trade

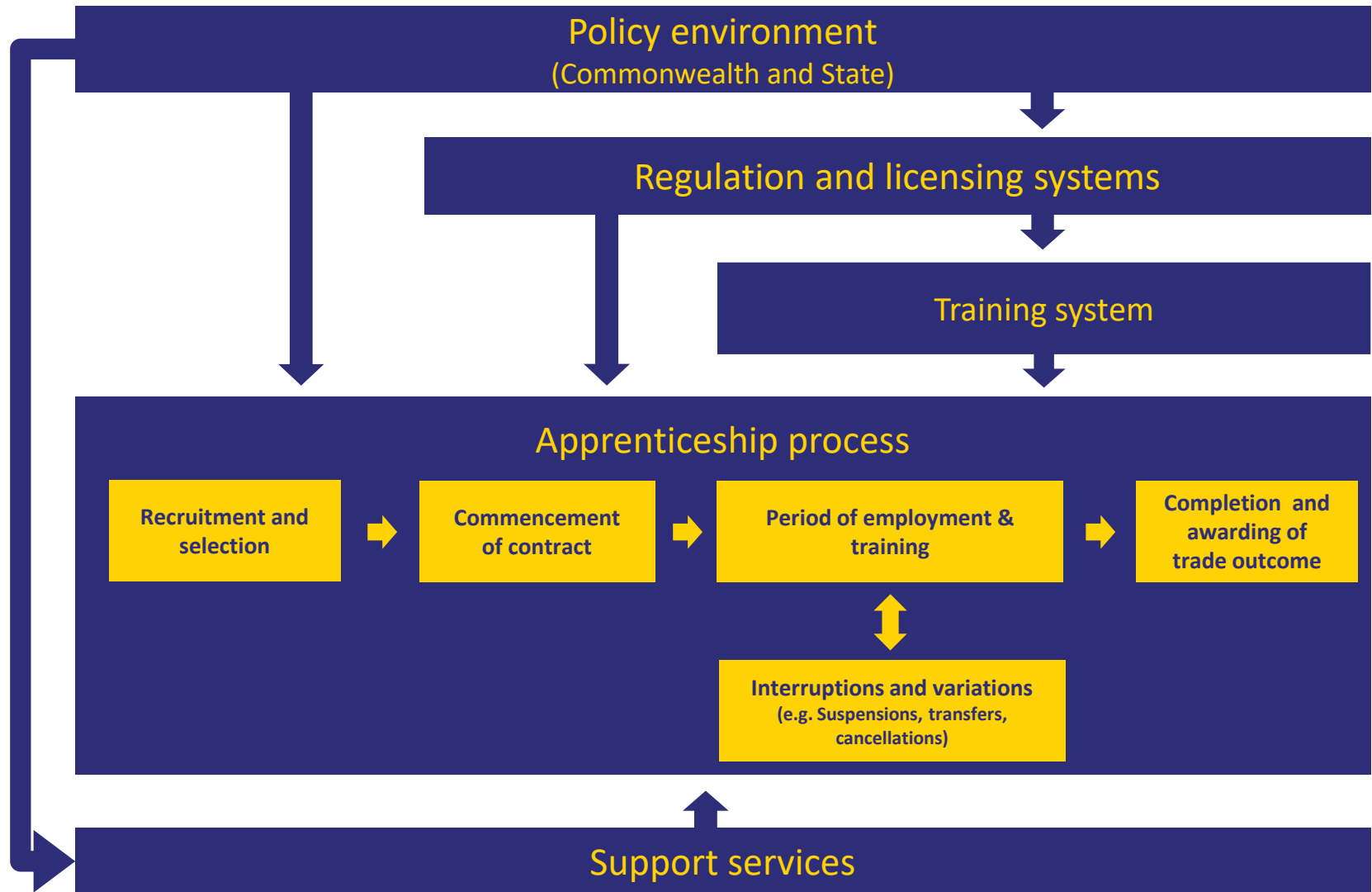
- Eg. Technicians and Trades Workers)
- 59.2% did training at TAFE
- Commencements in line with long term average
- In 2015, commencements went up by 0.9 per cent compared with 2014.

Non-Trade

- Eg. Managers, Professionals, Community and Personal Service Workers
- 17.5% did training at TAFE
- Decline in commencements since a 2012 peak
- 4.6% increase in commencements between March Quarters 2015 and 2016.
